So what does Arnold Schwarzenegger have to do with the Gators? Arnold was born in a small town called Thal, Austria. Less than 80 miles southwest is the town of Klagenfurt, the host city for this Sunday's Ironman Austria event. There will be two Gators participating in this event... Jon Wesler and Brian Kozera... and their families including Allison, Kristin, and all of their kids will be there to cheer them on. Back to that story in a minute...

It's been a little over four years since my first workout with the Y's triathlon training program that only about two years ago officially became the Spring Valley YMCA Multisport Gators club. And in that short time, it's been amazing to see many phenomenal comebacks started, in progress, and completed. There are too many to name, so I won't even try (with one exception), but it's one of our greatest strengths as a club... You're around so many amazing people doing amazing things every day, persevering through injuries, illnesses, and other difficulties that life has thrown at them that you cannot help but be inspired to be amazing yourself!

So back to Austria... Jon made arrangements for he and Brian to participate in the event about a year ago, shortly after Brian began his "I'll be back" journey from cancer on May 4, 2015 when he had a bone marrow transplant. Brian first joined our group sometime in early 2013 as he was preparing for that August's Ironman Louisville, which to date has been his first and only Ironman event (Brian does have an extensive background in looooong adventure races). Of course Brian successfully completed Ironman Louisville despite notoriously hot weather. Brian had some ambitious plans for races after that, but then the bottom dropped out... He was diagnosed with cancer. Brain battled it for a long time, all while he and Kristin raised three young daughters. Of course Brian won his battle, resumed his training, and this weekend he will complete his Ironman return with his first full distance event since Louisville. And it's fitting that he'll do so alongside his friend and our first club president, Jon. So if you have some time this Sunday, probably in the early afternoon, tune in to the live online coverage of Ironman Austria and you just might have a chance to see the two of them cross the finish line at which time Brian truly will be back (although I'm not sure he actually ever left)! Have a great race, guys!

NOTE: The event begins this Sunday, June 26 around 7am CEST (Austria time), which is 1amEDT for us. Expected finish time is a bit difficult to estimate, but likely sometime between 12:30pm-2pm our time. To follow their progress, go to www.ironman.com to access the main Ironman website... There is typically a "Live Event Coverage" link at the top of the page when a race is in progress, so it should be fairly easy to find on Sunday.
