Saturday, December 3

Rehoboth Beach Marathon and Half Marathon (Rehoboth Beach, DE)

Seven Gators started this event and seven Gators successfully crossed the finish line... **Kerri Brannen** and **Don Mack** completed the full marathon while **Tiff Pfluger**, **Diane Lynch**, **Chris Oswald**, **Kristen Oswald**, and **Maureen Pinkerton**. Also, some additional great individual results...

- •Diane set a HALF MARATHON PR!!!
- •Maureen also set a HALF MARATHON PR!!! Maureen also finished in the top 15% in her age group, the top 20 % of all females, and the top 25% of all race finishers!
- •Tiff finished in the top 2% of all female finishers, the top 5% in her age group (8th out of 172), and the top 6% of all race finishers (91st out of 1,547)!
- •Don finished in the top 5% of all race finishers and in the top 10% in his age group.
